In Root Juice, two players don carrot and daikon hats in order to work together to make as many root juices as they can within the time limit.

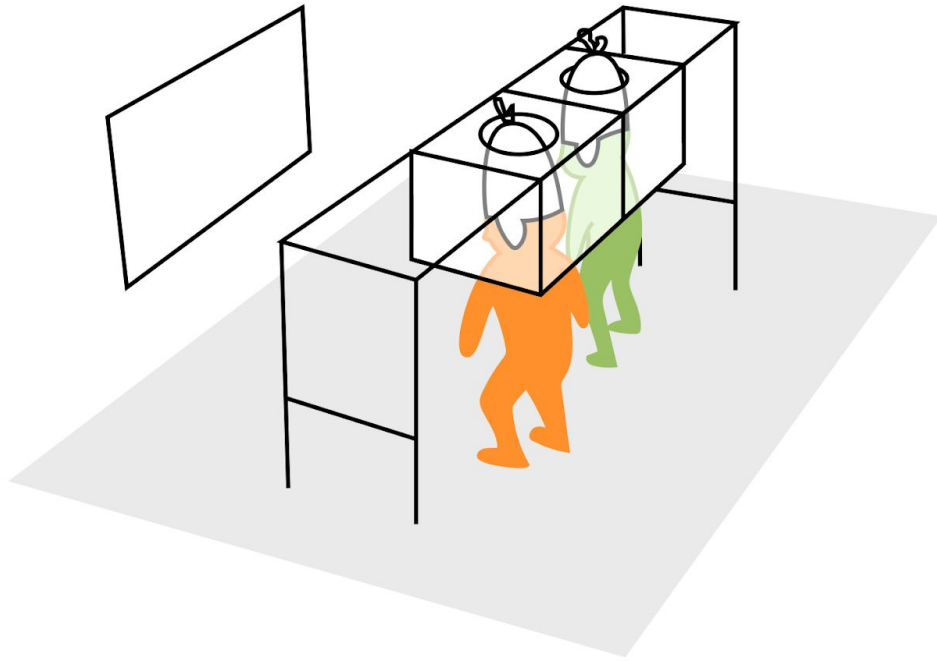
Players are shown a juice on screen of a color blended from orange and green. They must input the correct ratio of orange to green to match the juice. When they complete a juice, they get a new one.

In order to add their color (their vegetable), they must poke their hat out of the top of the box. The two players must communicate to determine how many times they must squat up and down in order to reach the correct ratio.

There are two hat choices, which lead to different strategies depending on player height. The short hat can encourage more jumping, and the tall hat can encourage more squatting, depending on the base height of the player.

In Peas Please, you are a pea pod, full of peas. You must deliver as many of your peas into the basket as you can within a minute!

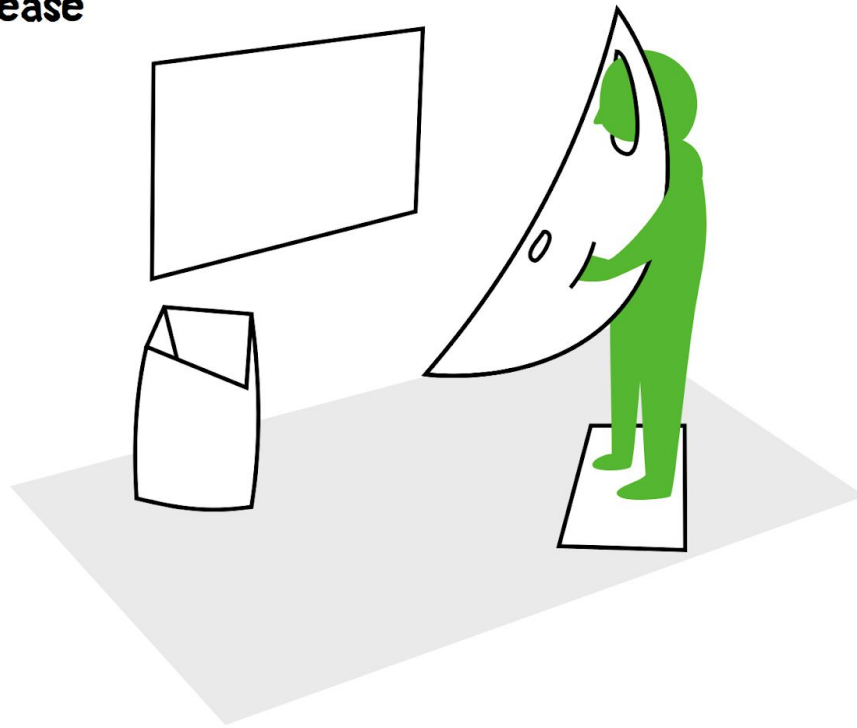
There are only two restrictions:

- Stay on the platform.
- Don't touch the peas directly with your hands.

The pod costume rests on your head or neck and protrudes from your torso. The midsection has a pouch of peas and a single hole. Next to the hole there are two pockets which allow you closer access to the balls so you can pop them out of the hole and into the basket.

Onion Dance

In Onion Dance, you start as a bare onion bulb. You try to grow as big as you can by putting on as many layers as you can within the time limit. Make sure you have the skin layer on last!

The bulb sits around torso level and is supported by shoulder straps. Each layer is connected to the bulb base at the top by velcro. As you add more layers, it gets more poofy and crowded, making it harder to continue adding layers.

So as to not be a naked onion, you must have the skin layer on last. The skin connects to both the top and bottom of the bulb, and can be used to hold all the mid-layers together.

During the game, there's a camera that provides a mirror view of yourself on screen. At the end of the time limit, a camera will automatically take your picture. Make sure you look good! The start screen displays the last couple of pictures, so you can compare yourself.
